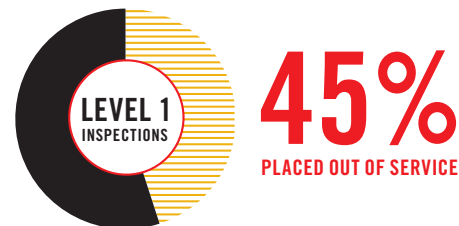


# CVSA Brake Safety Week is September 15–21.

In September, the Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance will have their second inspection in 2019 to support the Operation Airbrake Program, designed to improve commercial vehicle brake safety throughout North America.

Brake-related violations comprise the largest percentage of all out-of-service violations cited during roadside inspections. Improperly installed or poorly maintained brake systems can reduce the braking capacity and stopping distance of trucks, posing a serious risk to the driver, as well as public safety.
